**HIGHLIGHTS OF THE COURSE:**

We have eight courses or subjects in every semester, meanwhile, we have two semesters in one session which cover one year calendar. Six months for one semester which is January to June, and the last six months of the year is the second semester, which is July to December. And in every week (sat) we will be having four subjects to cover, the subjects you will have in first week is the same you will you have third week, and the subjects you will have in the second week is the same you will have in the last week of the months. Lectures are taken on Saturdays on site, and for online is Monday, Wednesday and Saturday, temporary for now.

## **DURATION/TIME SCHEDULE:**

The courses are run as follows:

1. Certificate - 2 Semesters

6. Professor – On contact and research works within 12 months.

Marks are awarded for attendance and active participation in class and seminar activities. To remain in good academic standings, students must successfully complete minimum unit (atleast) a cumulative grade on a minimum of units' courses and maximum of 28 units.

GPA of 2.0 for diploma and bachelor's degree on a minimum of 40 units courses and maximum of 45 units.

Only evangelical group, old Students association, track's group, Drama group and any group that shall be in the interest of the gospel may be allowed in the institution and shall be closely monitored.

9. All students must attend and participate in all practical assignments, projects or Ministerial duties within or outside the institutions. This aspect of the course carries 40 marks out of the course. Boycotting of classes or lecture is prohibited.

10. All aggrieved students should forward their grievances to the office of the Registrar for appropriate actions. No student shall take other students to the police or court in case of any grievance.

11. No student shall write or publish any article that may damage, or tarnish written by the students must be edited in the office of the registrar before being approved for publication.

12. All students must always be in possession of their institution's identity card for security purposes.

13. Visitors to be promptly attended to and treated politely and courteously.

14. Cleanliness leads to holiness, cleanliness of surroundings, classrooms, etc is essential.

15. Morning devotion every Saturday's 9:00- 10:00am. Must be promptly attended.

16. Extra- curricular activities are compulsory i.e. incidental assignments.

17. Daily schedule and timetable to be strictly adhered to.

18. Female students to be treated decently, honorably and compassionately.

19. Silence must be maintained during college hours.

20. Any act of, violence or gross indiscipline will attract summary dismissal.

21. Prayers and fasting would be periodically observed at a time to be announced by the college authority.
